MGM China Hosts Sixth ‘Health Day for the Elderly’ For Over 200 Elderlies

For the sixth consecutive year, MGM teams up with the Macau Chinese Medicine Association and rolls out the “Health Day for the Elderly” activity. Over 200 elderlies from four charity associations under Caritas Macau, Centro de Convívio “Kei Hong Lok Yuen” do Centro Pastoral da Areia Preta, Centro de Dia da Ilha Verde, Centro para Idosos da Casa Ricci and Centro de Dia “Brilho da Vida”, were invited to join this thoughtful and caring annual health day on September 21 at MGM MACAU’s Grand Ballroom.

During the activity, the elderlies were provided one-on-one medical consultations by 23 practitioners from the Macau Chinese Medicine Association, with the assistance of 60 MGM volunteer team members. Healthy herbal soups were prescribed for them after the medical consultations, which are beneficial to lungs and digestive system. In addition, the practitioners demonstrated an acupuncture-point massage therapy to the elderlies for them to practice this simple health exercise on a daily basis.
