First-ever Wedding Photo Opportunity at Double Celebration

To celebrate the 70th anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China and the 20th anniversary of the Macau SAR, MGM is bringing back "Love Moments" with 20 elderly couples for their first-ever wedding photos taken at the Spectacle of MGM COTAI, celebrating enduring love and beautiful life memories, and in appreciation for their past contributions to the community.

To many couples, wedding photos are important as they capture beautiful moments and a solemn promise of love. Yet, many senior citizens have never had their wedding photos taken back in their wedding times. In 2014 and 2015, MGM organized "Love Moments @ Grande Praça," where elderly couples were invited to have their first-ever wedding photos taken at MGM MACAU. The event gave them a truly memorable experience and received overwhelmingly positive responses from the community. This year, MGM is glad to bring back this meaningful wedding photo shooting experience as one of the highlights of the seventh consecutive MGM Community Care Campaign this year.

For the first time at MGM COTAI, 20 pairs of elderly couples are invited from the Women's General Association of Macau, Caritas Macau as well as from MGM employees' family. Their average age is over 70 years old with around 50 years of marriage; all have witnessed the rapid development of new China and the glorious days of the past 20 years of Macau's handover to China. Among them, the oldest couple are 92 and 81 years old, and the longest marriage is 62 years.

A warm and heartfelt ceremony was held today in MGM COTAI in which government officials, representatives from charitable associations, MGM management and family members of the couples were present to witness this joyous moment. Each couple receives a wedding photo album and one 40x60cm photo in frame, allowing it to pass down from generation to generation.

Delighted and excited, the elders were enthusiastically chatting with the volunteers about their love stories. “I got married when I was 20, now I am 82. I had no wedding ceremony when my husband and I got married. I would now have the chance to enjoy having tea with my grandchildren and to share our wedding photos. They need to see how stylish their grandparents can be!” said Cheong Lun Mui, the eldest bride of the group.
