

MGM Commemorates China's May Fourth Movement and Inspires Macau Youths on the Opportunities at the In-Depth Cooperation Zone in Hengqin

In commemoration of the 104th Anniversary of the "May Fourth Movement", MGM jointly organized the "MGM Commemoration of China's May Fourth Movement Activities" with Livelihood Affairs Bureau of Guangdong-Macao In-Depth Cooperation Zone in Hengqin (DSAS) and Macau Youth Federation. He encouraged the youth to seize the new development opportunities, take part in the "1+4" diverse development initiative of Macau, and ultimately contribute to the development of both GBA and the Zone. On the other hand, he also introduced the community support and facilities available in the Zone and the GBA.
